The meeting was called to order by President Gene Bennett. The agenda was approved as amended following a motion by Mr. Russell Lane and a second by Mr. Johnny Worsham. Following an executive session, no action was taken.

Mr. Mike Smith, superintendent, asked for approval to change the price for student lunches from \$2.25 to \$2.35 to comply with Federal guidelines and to accept the bid from Bimbo Bread as the bread vendor and Turner Dairy as the vendor for milk. Mr. Mark made a motion that the recommendations be approved. Mr. Johnny Worsham seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Smith recommended that David Mason be hired as a 7-12 art teacher. Mr. Russell Lane made a motion that the recommendation be approved. Mr. Johnny Worsham seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Mark Fincher made a motion that recommendations for stipends for added duties at the bus garage for Carolyn Faulkner (\$1500), Rodney Sparks (\$5000) and Don Barber (\$5000) be approved. Mr. Johnny Worsham seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Smith recommended that the salary schedule be adjusted to correct the discrepancy between the base salary of LEA supervisor and the principals by adding \$4000 to the base salary for principals. Mr. Darrell Gist made a motion that the superintendent's recommendation of \$4000 be amended to \$1500 added to the base salary for principals. Mr. Freddy Ware seconded the motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4 for and 1 against. Mr. Bennett, president, stated that at which time the incumbent supervisor retires, the supervisor's base salary on the salary schedule will be readjusted.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned following a motion by Mr. Russell Lane and a second by Mr. Johnny Worsham.
