Senior Parents!

Financial Aid for college can be stressful if you have never been through the process before. Our Career Coach David Diagostino is here to help ease some of that stress and has provided some information below to help you get this process completed.

1. Enrollment begins October 1st.
2. All seniors have FSA ID Set Up paperwork to complete that has a parent/guardian section.
3. October 9th and 10th seniors will complete the FSA ID set up in class.
4. October 17th Parent Teacher Conference
 - a. FAFSA filing will take place from 2-8pm. We will help you through the process.
 - b. College Knowledge for Parents will be available from 2-8pm as well.

Documents needed to file the FAFSA:

1. FSA ID (Student and Parent)
2. 2016 Tax Returns (Parent and student if they worked)
3. 2016 W2's
4. Social Security Number or Alien Registration Number (Parent and Student)
