Important Graduation Information

Arrival: Seniors need to be at the Junior High Library at 5:00 pm. Family members are not allowed in the halls or Library. The Senior Slideshow will be playing in the RHS Auditorium starting at 5:00 pm.

Dress Code: Seniors should wear dark dress clothes with black or dark brown shoes. NO SPIKES OR NARROW HIGH HEELS. If your footwear will harm the field, you will not be allowed on the field in them. Please be sure you can walk at speed during the ceremony. Blue jeans are not allowed. No tennis shoes or flip flops/slides. Caps may NOT be decorated.

Parking: The west entrance to RHS will be closed off except to seniors and working RHS faculty and staff to park on the west side of the building. All others should use the parking lots to the east of the Auditorium.

Bad Weather Alternative: Seniors should make sure their family members bring their tickets in case bad weather forces the ceremony inside the Auditorium. No one will be allowed in the Auditorium without a ticket. Overflow will be placed in the gymnasium.

Stadium Information: No one is allowed on the field/track before, during, or after the Graduation Ceremony. Trespassers may be prosecuted. Pictures may not be taken on the field or track. Seniors and their guests may use the Band practice field or the EAST entrance to the Auditorium.
