Keiser Elementary

Hiring of Pre-K aide to assist in quality instruction for 4 yr. olds

Hiring of instructional assistants to work under the supervision of certified teachers to provide interventions for students not proficient in grade level work -

Hiring of a nurse, exceeding the State Standards requirement to meet the physical and medical needs of the students

Providing an after school program in preparation for Benchmark assessments

Purchasing of materials and supplies for literacy including but not limited to supplemental books for classroom libraries and materials for literacy units

Hiring of a literacy coach to provide professional development and support for teachers in literacy

Hiring of an interventionist to work with students individually and in small groups under the supervision of a certified teacher

Hiring of a nurse, exceeding the State Standards requirement, to meet the physical and medical needs of the students

Purchasing of supplemental materials and supplies for implementation of Common Core.

Wilson Elementary

Hiring of a pre-K aide for the –preschool 4 year old classroom.

Hiring of a school resource officer to support a safe and drug-free environment in the school.

Hiring of a nurse, exceeding the State Standards requirement, to meet the physical and medical needs of the students

Purchasing of technology equipment including with 30 laptops for use in the library, two network printers, multi-touch Smartboards with mounted projectors to be used for instruction in the classroom

Purchasing of literacy materials and supplies including but not limited to books, supplement units, charts and writing materials.

Purchasing of math manipulatives to provide concrete experiences in the development of the understanding of math processes.

Providing materials, travel, communication and training in support of a Career Coach's services in the school.

Hiring of an academic coach to provide professional development and support for teachers

Purchasing the services of the Arkansas Leadership Academy to provide intense training, guidance and support to the administration.

Providing services by school personnel for tutoring beyond the school day and transportation for students to attend as needed.

Supporting a safe environment for learning by providing security personnel .
