Rivercrest Elementary

Hiring of Pre-K aides to assist in quality instruction for 4 yr. olds

Materials and Supplies for PK curriculum (1105) - \$8,000

Instructional assistants will work under the supervision of certified teachers to provide Interventions for students not proficient in grade level work - (1590)

Literacy Tutor

Hire a literacy coach to provide professional development and support for teachers in literacy

Hire two School Resource Officers

Two nurses, exceeding the State Standards requirement hired to meet the physical and medical needs of the students

NSLA funds will be used for materials and supplies including but not limited to supplemental materials and supplies and software for literacy and math, desktop computers, tablets and chrome books

Software for math fluency and Nexus tablets

Rivercrest High School

RHS will work with Arkansas Northeastern College to purchase services of a Career Coach in the school.

Interim assessment testing coordinated by The Learning Institute will be administered in literacy, math and science.. Results will be used to guide instruction

License for software for core areas will be purchased

Certified teachers and instructional assistant will work with the regular education teachers to provide an alternative learning environment for qualifying students who need help and support to function successfully.

A school resource officer and surveillance equipment which will provide safety and security-

Math interventions will be provided for students performing below grade level. The math interventionists will tutor students in small groups to address deficits as defined by test data.

Description: NSLA funds will be used to purchase math and literacy materials including but not limited to: supplemental materials for the core areas and technology for instruction. **These materials will be used for students to develop projects, for skill practice, for support of the 1 to 1 device initiative, for supplemental books for student use across the curriculum including:**

--Upgrade of the math lab with 30 new computers for student use.
