

Rivercrest School Choice

Rivercrest School District is a participant in School Choice and will consider applications for attendance from nonresident students which are in compliance with applicable laws & regulations. A copy of the application form must be received by **both** the resident and non-resident school. Each application form will be stamped with the date and time it is received in our Superintendent's office at 22 North Jefferson in Wilson. Applications will be prioritized based upon the date and time received. The superintendent will consider all applications for School Choice **postmarked no later than May 1** proceeding the fall semester the applicant would begin school in the District.

The superintendent shall notify the parent or guardian and the student's resident district, in writing, by **July 1** of the decision to accept or reject the application. When considering applications, priority will be given to applications from siblings or stepsiblings residing in the same residence or household of students already attending the District through school choice. The District may reject a nonresident's application for admission if its acceptance would necessitate the addition of staff or classrooms, exceed the capacity of a program, class, grade level, or school building, or cause the District to provide educational services not currently provided in the affected school. Students admitted under this policy shall be entitled to continue enrollment until they graduate or are no longer eligible for enrollment in the District's schools.
